

Austin High Swimming Press Release for the Aggieland “Bob Stallings” Invitational, 11/9/25

On Saturday, November 9, the Austin High Swimming & Diving team competed at the Aggieland “Bob Stallings” Invitational on the campus of Texas A&M University. The meet attracted over 850 swimmers on 35 teams from across the state. Both the Maroon boys and girls teams finished in 19th among all the team in the team standings.

The Maroons were led by three swimmers and one diver who all scored among the top 100 athletes of the meet in the NISCA Power Point rankings. NISCA Power Points are calculated using a formula that awards points to each athlete’s individual race and how close their time was to the All-American standard.

Among the 850 swimmers at the meet, senior Kole Esselstyn finished 35th, junior Evan Smith finished in 55th, junior Coco Crosby finished in 62nd, and freshman diver Georgia Henry finished in 95th. Esselstyn had the highest individual finish for the Maroons, winning the consolation heat of the 100 backstroke for a 9th place finish.

The Austin High swimmers competed in 52 individual races on Saturday, with 25 of those swims (48%) coming in as new personal best times for the athletes.

The following athletes contributed points for the Maroons by scoring in the top 16 in their respective races:

Kole Esselstyn (SR) – 200 IM (13th); 100 backstroke (9th)

Coco Crosby (JR) – 200 medley relay (11th); 100 backstroke (10th)

Sora Jenkins (SR) – 200 medley relay (11th)

Skylar Jones (SO) – 200 medley relay (11th)

Mia Corbin (JR) – 200 medley relay (11th)

Evan Smith (JR) – 50 freestyle (13th)

Georgia Henry (FR) – diving (14th)
